Call to Order

Program

- It is a real problem to sort out the trustworthy sources of news from the overwhelming number of news outlets, substacks, and organizations.
- There was little response to questions about joining the club committees or finding a president for 2025.
- Conclusion: we will have the round tables again in March and a new set of questions to discuss after the program. Bob will limit the number of emails we send out to avoid adding to the overload.
