

Summary of Changes Proposed Bylaws Approved by Board of Directors 9/12/23

This document has been prepared to provide a summary of proposed changes to The Grand Democrats Bylaws amended 1.26.22.

NOTE : Proposed Bylaw changes are shown in **BOLD print**. Words, phrases and sentences 'crosssed out' will be deleted from text of this document when Bylaws are approved. Universal Change : Sun City Grand to The Grand or Grand.

Article I, Section C, Capitalizes Policical Action Committee

Article 2,

Section A. Membership : Creates two membership categories. Changes names of membership categories from Member and Donor Friend to Resident Member and Guest Member and defines each category.

Section C. Due : removes January 1st as a due deadline to «upon joining or membership renewal.

Acticle IV. Officers

B. Vice-President : created one paragraph rather than three.

D. Treasurer. Removes Secretary in Treasurer's absence to Treasurer, or designee, to comply with Arizona statue.

Secton E. Removed « Duties and Responsibilities of to Members-at-Large.

Article V.

Section A. Changed title and made Elections and Nominations regular standing committees, no longer Ad-Hoc. Combined Program and Public Relations Committees

into one. Changes Webmaster to Technical Committee. Minor wording changes. Assigns Section Letters to each committee description.

Section C. Elections Committee : minor wording changes.

Section D. Fundraising Committee : minor word changes

Section F. Nominations Committee : restructured this committee reducing minimum number to two from three and maximum from four to three. Institutes a 20 day notification period to the membership from the November meeting election date.

Section G. Program and Public Relations Committee : rewording due to combination of the committees.

Section H. Technical Committee : redines the rôle to be more than the website coordination including use of communication software tools like Mailchimp and Tockify.

Aarticle VII- Amendments

Section A. Bylaws. Changes presentation of proposed amendments from « may » to « shall. »

Article VIII-Miscellaneous

Section D. Contract, etal

Removes authority of the Board to designate a Treasurer designee to the Treasurer per state statute.
